3 Day Kings Canyon Ayers Rock(Uluru)

Comfortable Small Group Outback Journeys

A small group accommodated nature experience that gets you off the highway and onto outback roads and tracks to explore the spectacular delights of The Red Centre. Experience the outback at an unhurried pace, view exotic eco systems, explore diverse desert landscapes and witness the ever changing colours of Central Australia. Discover the people, their culture and the landscape in the comfort of modern air conditioned vehicle along with international standard resort accommodation, and a passionate, knowledgeable, local guide.

Day 1 Alice Springs to Kings Canyon

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Avoiding the crowds, we travel along Larapinta Drive to Wallace Rockhole, an aboriginal community and join the rock art tour. Explore Gosse Bluff (Tnorala), a comet impact crater 130 million years old. Learn of it's aboriginal significance in this unique natural environment. Further to the south we pass through Katapata Gap and transverse the Mereenie Wilderness Area to the top of the jump-up, where we have an uninterrupted view of the George Gill Range and Carmicheals Crag.

Day 2 Kings Canyon to Ayers Rock (Uluru)

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This morning a climb to the rim of Kings Canyon, with time to explore the Garden of Eden, wonder at the exquisite environment of the George Gill Range. Enroute through vast cattle stations to Yulara we stop at Mt Connor Lookout, often mistaken for Ayers Rock. This afternoon we visit the Uluru - Kata Tjuta Cultural Centre, before an informative base tour of Uluru, including Mutitjulu waterhole and Kantju Gorge, enjoy a champagne sunset overlooking Uluru.

Accom: Ayers Rock Resort (choice of accommodation)

Day 3 The Olgas (Kata Tjuta)

Early morning we head off to the west to explore The Olgas (Kata Tjuta). In the serenity of the cool morning air, we view Kata Tjuta from the top of the sand dune lookout before exploring some of the deep canyon like valleys which are full of life and colour upon returning to Yulara in time to investigate the Visitor Centre. This afternoon we return to Alice Springs via the Stuart Highway. *Note: This tour can terminate at Ayers Rock Resort*
