6 Day Red Centre Getaway

Small Group Outback Journeys

A small group accommodated nature experience that gets you off the highway and onto outback roads and tracks to explore the spectacular delights of the Red Centre. Experience the outback at an unhurried pace, view exotic eco systems, explore diverse desert landscapes and witness the ever changing colours of Central Australia. Discover the people, their culture and the landscape in the comfort of modern air conditioned vehicles and international standard resort accommodation, with a passionate knowledgeable local guide

Day 1 Arrive Alice Springs

Free afternoon to explore Alice (optional touring available)
Accom: Voyages Alice Springs Resort Standard

Day 2 Alice to Kings Canyon

Avoiding the crowds, we travel along Larapinta Drive to Wallace Rockhole, an aboriginal community and join the rock art tour. Explore Gosse Bluff (Tnorala), a comet impact crater 130 million years old. Learn of its aboriginal significance in this unique natural environment. Further to the south we cross through Katapata Gap and the Mereenie Wilderness Area to the top of the jump-up, where we have an uninterrupted view of the George Gill Range and Carmichaels' Crag.

Day 3 Kings Canyon Ayers Rock(Uluru)

This morning a climb to the rim of Kings Canyon, with time to explore the Garden of Eden, wonder at the exquisite environment of the George Gill Range. Enroute through vast cattle stations to Yulara we stop at Mt Connor Lookout (often mistaken for Ayers Rock). This afternoon we visit the Uluru - Kata Tjuta Cultural Centre, before an informative base tour of Ayers Rock (Uluru), including Mutitjula and Kantju Gorge before enjoying a champagne sunset overlooking Uluru.

Day 4 The Olgas (KataTjuta)to Alice

Early morning we head off to the west to explore The Olgas (Kata Tjuta). In the serenity of the cool morning air, we view Kata Tjuta from the top of the sand dune lookout before exploring some of the deep canyon like valleys which are full of life and colour upon returning to Yulara in time to investigate the Visitor Centre prior to our afternoon journey to Alice Springs.

Day 5 Palm Valley

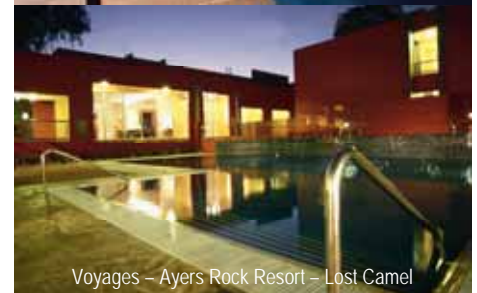
Explore the Finke Gorge National Park and Palm Valley Enjoy a leisurely stroll along Palm Creek absorbing the ambience of this desert oasis. A more vigorous option is a climb to the top of the valley walls. Cycad Gorge offers an impressive cliff display of these rare plants, Kalarranga Lookout affords an impressive view of the amphitheatre, a site of significance for the local Aranda people. Hermannsburg is our next stop, time to explore this historical mission and stroll amongst the buildings in awe at the achievements in a hostile environment. Tour the gallery of the famous water colour artists of Hermannsburg. View the works of the father of this water colour art style Albert Namatjira. Purchase genuine works of art and artifacts of the sons and daughters of Hermannsburg. Return to Alice Springs late afternoon.

Day 6 West MacDonnell Ranges L

A day of spectacular mountain scenery, wildlife and waterholes. Visit Flynn's Grave, view The Twin Gums painted by Albert Namatjira a famous aboriginal water colour artist. Explore Standley Chasm a rare geological formation of two opposing red rock faces. The Ochre Pits are a significant traditional source of ochre for ceremonies as we gain a panoramic view of the beginning of one of the oldest rivers in the world at the Finke River Lookout. Swim in an outback waterhole at Ellery Creek and explore Ormiston Gorge a permanent waterhole set amongst deep ravines and peaked mountains before returning to the Alice via Simpsons Gap. Tour concludes approx 5.30pm
